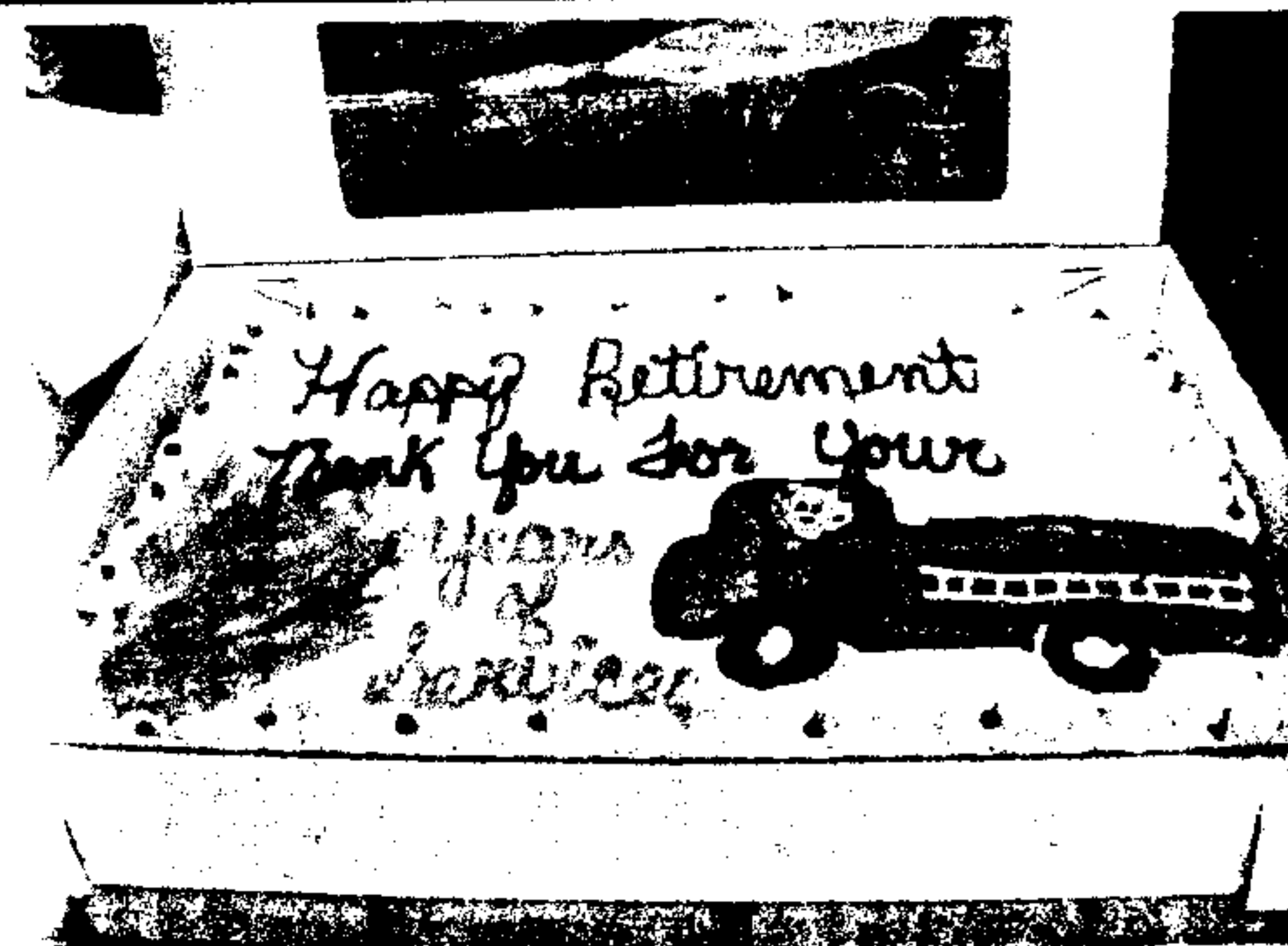

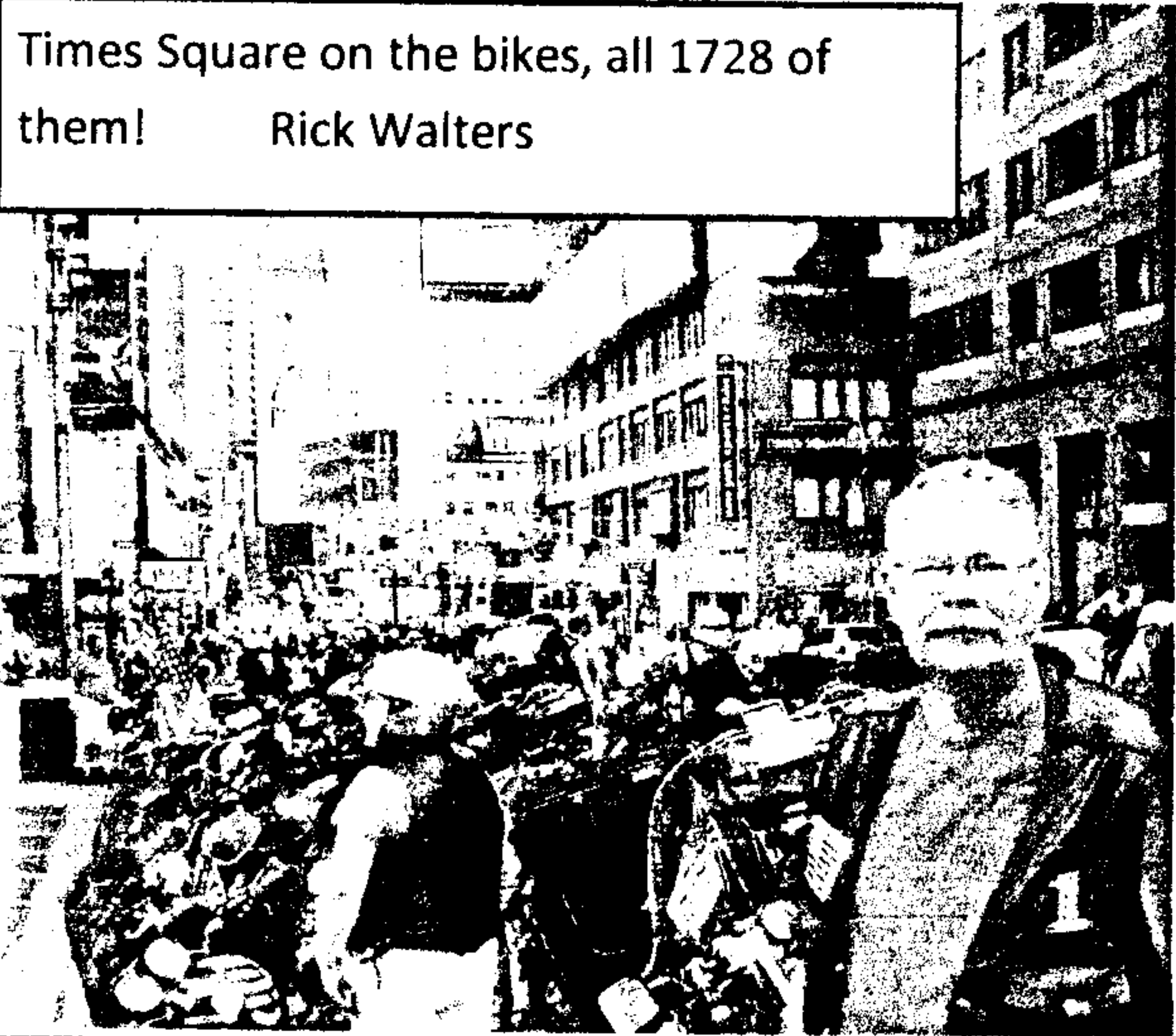

Greeting to the Stark County Firefighters Association.

My name is Keane O. Toney, I am a retired Sgt. from the Canton Police Department. As public servant of over 29.5 yrs I witnessed the impact that mental illness has on individuals, families, and the public. I began my public service as a part time Firefighter in the city of Alliance for two summers. I then moved to the law enforcement side of public service that lasted almost 3 decades. In both capacities I personally have witnessed the impact of mental illness on everyone.

On October 1, 2011 the Stark County NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness) will be folding a walk to support mental health at the Hoover Park Connector in North Canton. Our registration starts at 9:00 am and the walk starts at 10:30 am. The course is a 2.2 mile course. I am requesting your assistance and support.

Mental illness contributes to behavior that leads to fire service intervention, either through fire calls, traffic accident or medic runs on a regular basis. Many individuals such as me have family members or friends that have been impacted by mental illness. These two circumstances demonstrate the importance of NAMI Stark County and its service to the community. These needs also demonstrate the importance in community partnership.

I am requesting that the Stark County Firefighters Association sponsor or have a team participating in the walk. The team can be comprised of Stark County Firefighters Association present, past members, family and/or friends. Anyone that your association wants can participate in their team. Display of such support would demonstrate the commitment made by the Stark County Firefighters Association to their continued community service.
